GENERAL NATURE OF JOB DUTIES	
Bridge Health is seeking an LPN to join our Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (IDD) Nursing Team. Individual will be responsible for assessing patients daily, providing nursing care. Facilitating communication between individuals served, providers, staff, and outside stakeholders such as doctor's offices. LPN in this role will provide these services in the community in the homes of the individuals served. LPN selected will have an agency vehicle or be reimbursed for mileage if an agency vehicle is not available for travel. LPN will provide up to 40 hours per week of nursing services and /or staff/Host Home provider training related to care of the individual served. Documentation and communication are important pieces of this position. Schedule flexibility is preferred in order to meet the needs of the individual served. Position will be full time and benefits eligible. Paid Time Off, Paid Holidays, and Flex Time are a part of the benefits package. Nursing hours are primarily located in Chattooga and Walker County.
